Collecting Data

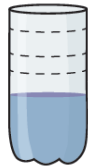


Do you think there will be less rainfall in spring and summer than in winter and autumn?

Rainfall - The amount of rain that falls in one place.



Rain gauge - An object used to collect rainfall.



Sticky Knowledge

As seasons change so does the weather and the length of the day.

There are four seasons: autumn, spring, summer, winter.

Air temperature changes across the seasons.

Vocabulary

It is lighter for longer in **summer** and **spring**.



In one year, there are four **seasons**: **autumn**, **spring**, **summer**, and **winter**.

Season - A part of the year.

Daylight - light from the Sun.



Weather - the conditions outside.



Night - a period of darkness each day when there is no daylight.

Enquiry Question: What are the main changes in each season?

Spring

- In spring, plants start to grow.
- In spring, some trees regrow their leaves.
- There are more daylight hours and the nights are shorter in spring.
- The weather often changes quickly in spring.

Summer

- Summer is usually the warmest season.
- Some trees start to lose their leaves in autumn.
- Some trees lose all their leaves in winter.
- Plants begin to flower in spring.
