


<u>Nursery Newsletter HT3</u>




<u>Reminders</u>

<u>-</u>We are a water-only school. No juice or flavoured water please.

-Label your child's belongings. -If your child is due to start Reception in 2025 remember you need to apply for a place. -Leave a change of clothes in school in case of accidents. -Inform us if your child will be absent from Nursery. If your child does not attend regularly they risk losing their place.





<u>Bookbags</u> Bookbags need returning every WEDNESDAY, they will only be changed on this day. The children will have the opportunity to take home a library book each week in their bags.

<u>Homework</u>

As last half term a homework grid will be going home on the first week back in book bags. You can then tick them off like Bingo as you complete each activity! Children only need to complete 1 a week.



<u>Outdoor Provision</u>

Children have access to outdoor provision every day. Please make sure they are dressed appropriately. A warm coat with their name in. Practise putting hats, coats and gloves on. Footwear needs to be appropriate for the weather.
