

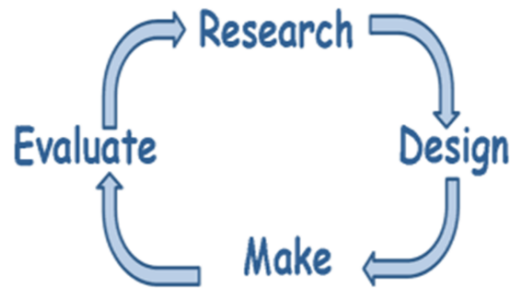




- Use utensils to make my product

Vocabulary you will learn throughout this unit...

Vocabulary	Definition
make	Create by putting parts together.
pattern 	A repeated decorative design.
cut 	Using a knife or scissors you can cut different shapes or pieces out.
sewing 	Using a needle to thread something together or to make a pattern.
Evaluating 	<p>Assessing how well your product matches its criteria.</p> <p>Discuss the positives and the negatives.</p>
Materials 	Something you can use to make or decorate something with, you can use more than one.
textiles 	A type of cloth or woven fabric
design 	Drawing and labelling your ideas of what to make.
joining 	Connecting 2 pieces of material together.
decorate	To make something look better/ change the appearance by adding extra items.
mark-out	Drawing an outline of a design to be cut out.
