A quick guide to Nursery

Session Times

30 hours (for eligible working parents)

Monday - Friday 8:45 - 3:15 (32.5 hours)

There is a £9 per week for the extra 2.5 hours or you can collect early at 2.45pm Wed/Thur/Fri.

Parents need to apply for a code online to access these places on a first come-first served basis.

2.5 days:

Monday and Tuesday 8:45-3:15 Wednesday 8:45-11:45

Thursday and Friday 8:45-3:15 Wednesday 12:15-3:15

Morning sessions:

8:45-11:45

Afternoon sessions:

12:15-3:15

Doors open at **3:10** for children with older siblings.

It is important your child is collected on time.

Keyworker Groups

Your child will be assigned a keyworker. This will ensure they are in the same small group each day for quick activities and to enable them to make friends.

You will always drop your child and collect them from their keyworker group in the classroom.

Please can you **always** ensure you take your child directly to their keyworker to sit down at the beginning of the session. This enables us to see who is in each group and share any news with parents/carers.

How to help

Library Books

One of the best ways to help your child is to read to them at home. Each group has a box of library books. Your child will bring one home every Wednesday to share with you.
